Entry Deadline: Film and Entry for due on Monday, April 17, 2017

We are currently accepting film entries from Pre-K through grade 12 students enrolled in the Steubenville City School District only.

SSFF Entry Rules

- Films may be submitted by individuals or by groups- be sure to credit every person that helps with your film.
- Films must be written, directed, edited, and produced by STUDENTS, with reasonable adult assistance.
- Films must be school appropriate- no profanity, nudity, bullying, or inappropriate content. All films will be approved by SHS faculty for appropriateness.
- Films must be between 5 to 15 minutes long. Films not meeting the time requirement will be automatically disqualified.
- Films should not be more than 8 GB in size, and all films should be submitted on a USB drive or disc which WILL NOT be returned (Please label the film with your name, grade, and contact number).
- Films may be disqualified at the film club advisors' discretion based on these rules and available space.
- Qualified submissions will be judged on Script (20 pts.), Creativity (30 pts.), Technical Quality (30 pts.) and Engagement (20 pts.)
- Cash prizes will be awarded for the best in each category: Colt (pre-k –grade 4), Stallion (grades 5-8) and Man o' War (grades -12); Best in Show; and Fan Favorite.

Films and completed entry forms must be submitted by 2:30 P.M. Monday, April 17, 2017 to Steubenville High School c/o Mr. Lew Smith 420 N. Fourth St. Steubenville, Ohio 43952.

Students will be notified when their film has qualified for the festival by Friday, April 21, 2017. Qualified entries will be screened at the Second Annual SHS Student Film Festival on Saturday, April 29, 2017. There will be cash prizes awarded to winning films in different categories.
